Regulations on the Organization of Curriculum Committee

1. The Curriculum Committee (hereafter referred to as the Committee) is organized in accordance with the University Regulations Code Session 24 and the University Organization Regulations.

2. Director of the Committee and the Committee Members

➤ The Dean of the Office of Academic Affairs serves as the director of the Committee members.

➤ Other committee members are as follows:

◆ Dean of the Student Affairs

◆ Chief Information Officer

◆ Director of General Education Center

◆ Director of Life-long Education

◆ Five Deans of Colleges

◆ Associate Dean of Colleges

◆ All Chairpersons of Departments

◆ Director of Office of International Affairs

◆ Director of International Language and Culture Center

◆ Director of Physical Education Office

- ◆ Director of Military Education Office
- Other members below will also be invited to involve in the curriculum planning.
- ◆ 1-2 off-campus experts or scholars or industrial personages
- ◆ 1-2 Student Representatives including graduating students

3. The Committee's Missions are as follows:

- A. Draw Up University's guiding principles of curriculum offered
- B. Validate University's cross-college program and the core curriculum
- C. Call a meeting to discuss University's cross - college/department/school/class/**group** curriculum required and the revision of programs.
- D. Coordinate and integrate the resources of curriculum and Faculty
- E. Plan required general courses and establish or revise years of attendance
- F. Validate the criteria of verification of University's new curriculum

4. The committee calls a meeting at least once per semester.

5. The regulations on the Organization of the Curriculum Committee are passed by the Academic Affairs Meeting and implemented afterwards.
