Regulations Regarding Students Taking The Passed Course

- 1. These regulations are established according to the matters passed by the fifth Academic Affairs Meting of the 1995 School Year on December 20, 1995.
- 2. Students may take the same course they have already passed for once only and will be recorded on the transcript; they are applied to the University's rule that those who have failed over half of all courses (in terms of credits) shall be ordered to withdraw from schooling. The credit will be counted only once into the required credits for graduation.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
