Yuan Ze University Regulations for Five-year Integrated Undergraduate and Graduate Program

Passed by the 4th Academic Affairs Meeting of the 1999 School Year, on January 5, 2000 Amended by the 5th Academic Affairs Meeting of the 1999 School Year, on February 21, 2000 Amended by the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2001 School Year, on September 19, 2001 Amended by the 3rd Amended by the 3rd Academic Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2009, on January 13, 2010 Amended by the 3rd Academic Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2014, on January 14, 2015

- Article 1 These regulations are established to encourage excellent undergraduate students in the University to keep studying our master's program, and for the purpose of coherent learning and shortening the years of study.
- Article 2 Students with excellent academic performance for all semesters may apply for the program before enrolling the second semester of their junior year. Regulations for admission quota, qualifications, requirements, screening procedures shall be established by relevant departments/colleges and these regulations shall be effective after being approved by the University's Academic Affairs Meeting.
- Article 3 Students who are admitted to the program have both qualifications for being candidates for a bachelor degree and being preparatory students for master's program.
- Article 4 Preparatory students who are admitted to the program must get the bachelor degree in their senior year, and must be admitted as the University's graduate students through recommendation or through examination.
- Article 5 Preparatory students who are admitted to the program may apply for the credit exemption. As for the credit exemption, graduate school courses taken during undergraduate years (students should fill out the credit approval form for graduate school courses first) may be exempted to at most three-fourths of the required graduate school credits (not including the credits for thesis; can be exceptions from the regulations for maximum of credit exemption for graduate school). If the credits of graduate school courses taken have been calculated as undergraduate credits, however, students may not apply for credit exemption any more.
- Article 6 Preparatory students who are admitted to the program shall meet all requirements for receiving a bachelor or a master degree made by both undergraduate and graduate

departments to be issued with their diplomas for both degrees.

Article 7 These regulations will be adopted by the Academic Affairs Meeting before being reported to the President for ratification and implementation, as shall amendments when they are made.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
