YZU Regulations for Appointing University Professor

Passed by the 20th Administrative Committee of the 2005 School Year, July 3, 2006

- Article 1 "YZU Regulations for Appointing University Professor" (hereafter, 'these regulations') are established to treat full-time faculties who have outstanding contributions to University with high respect.
- Article 2 Full-time faculties who have one of the following qualifications may be recommended to be a university professor:
 - 1. Having made outstanding contributions to University's development.
 - 2. Having shown excellence in the academic field with outstanding achievements and have been rewarded with significant academic awards or academic lecture courses in or out of University.
- Article 3 President shall appoint a university professor by selecting from University's qualified faculties. The quota of a university professor will not be calculated into the total quota of a college, department or office. President may command Secretariat Office or relevant colleges to offer administrative support for a university professor.
- Article 4 Teaching hours of a university professor shall be the same as those of University's lecture course professor.
- Article 5 President may ask a university professor to assist to promote the affairs of teaching, research, counseling and service.
- Article 6 A university professor may be invited by relevant colleges to give related speeches, and they may also be the project director or give suggestions about the development of colleges.
- Article 7 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, these regulations have been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.
- If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
