2 Accommodation Fees:

For undergraduate students in Dormitory 1, the fee is NT\$10,580 per semester (excluding winter/summer vacations and the New Student English Camp); Dormitory 2, NT\$12,650 per semester (excluding winter/summer vacations and the New Student English Camp)

For graduate students, the fee is NT\$13,800 per semester (including winter/summer vacations).

3 Computer and Network Communication Usage Fee:

(1) Undergraduate students in their first, second, and third years: NT\$1,000; Master's first-year students: NT\$300 (Starting from the academic year 111 - applicable to programs/classes listed in the admissions brochure).

(2) Graduate first-year students: NT\$1,000 (Starting from the academic year 113 - applicable to the programs/classes listed in the admissions brochure).

(3) For first-year undergraduate students: NT\$1,000; for first-year graduate students: NT\$1,000 (Starting from the academic year 113 - applicable to programs/ classes not listed in the admissions brochure).

4 Sports Facility Maintenance Fee:

(1) Freshman, sophomore, and junior students are charged NT\$600. Master's students in their first year are charged NT\$300 (applicable from the academic year 111 for new students).

(2) Graduate first-year students: NT\$300 (Starting from the academic year 113 - applicable to the programs/classes listed in the admissions brochure).

(3) For first-year undergraduate students: NT\$600; for first-year graduate students: NT\$300 (Starting from the academic year 113 - applicable to programs/ classes not listed in the admissions brochure).

5 For extension students in the undergraduate program, full tuition and fees are charged if they enroll in 10 credits or more per semester.

6 For undergraduate extension students who enroll in 9 credits or fewer per semester, they will be charged credit fees plus miscellaneous fees. The credit fee varies by college: Engineering, Information, Electrical and Communication, School of Nursing, and CZSD @ NT\$1,510. College of Management @ NT\$1,400. College of Humanities and Social Sciences @ NT\$1,390. Miscellaneous fees are calculated based on the proportion of enrolled credits to 9 credits. If enrolled credits are less than 1 credit (including non-course enrollment), it is calculated as 1 credit. Please refer to

7 For graduate students (including doctoral students from the fourth year onwards and master's students from the third year onwards) who are extension students, full tuition and miscellaneous fees are charged if they enroll in 10 credits or more per semester.

8 For graduate students (including doctoral students from the fourth year onwards and master's students from the third year onwards) who are extension students and enroll in 9 credits or fewer per semester, they will be charged credit fees as follows: College of Engineering, Information, Electrical and Communication @ NT\$1,610; College of Management @ NT\$1,510; College of Humanities and Social Sciences @ NT\$1,500; Graduate Institute of Medicine @ NT\$1,610. Additionally, miscellaneous fees are charged at 50% of the departmental standard. For the in-service Master's Program of College of Management, tuition is NT\$2,500 plus miscellaneous fees of NT\$5,135; Doctoral Program in the Industry Group has a tuition of NT\$12,000 plus miscellaneous fees of NT\$5,135. Credits less than 1 (including those not requiring course selection) are calculated as 1 credit.
