2 Accommodation Fees:

- Dorm 1 & 2: For undergraduate students the fee is NTS\$11,250 per semester (excluding winter/summer vacations and the early entry for New Student Event); For graduate student, the fee is NTS\$14,650 per semester (including winter/summer vacations)
- Dorm 3: For undergraduate students the fee is NTS\$13,450 per semester (excluding winter/summer vacations and the early entry for New Student Event)
- Off-campus dorm, Dorm Jixian: Room for two is NTS\$24,000 per semester(including winter/summer vacations) ; single room is NTS\$39,000 per semester(including winter/summer vacations)

3 All usage fees are charged in accordance with the standard duration of study for each academic program: 4 academic years for undergraduate programs, 2 academic years for master's programs (professional and specialized), and 3 academic years for doctoral programs.

- Computer and Network Communication Usage Fee: (1) For students enrolled in academic years 111 - 114 (as listed in the admissions brochure): undergraduate first- and second-year students shall pay NTS\$1,000 per semester.
(2) For students enrolled from academic year 115 onward (including those not listed in the admissions brochure): undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students (including in-service/professional programs) shall pay NTS\$1,000 per semester.
- Sports Facility Maintenance Fee: (1) For students enrolled in academic years 111 - 114 (as listed in the admissions brochure): undergraduate first-, second-, and third-year students shall pay NTS\$600 per semester.
(2) For students enrolled from academic year 115 onward (including those not listed in the admissions brochure): undergraduate shall pay NTS\$600, and master's, and doctoral students (including in-service/professional programs) shall pay NTS\$300 per semester.

4 For extension students in the undergraduate program, full tuition and fees are charged if they enroll in 10 credits or more per semester.

5 For undergraduate extension students who enroll in 9 credits or fewer per semester, they will be charged credit fees plus miscellaneous fees. The credit fee varies by college: Engineering, Information, Electrical and Communication, School of Nursing, and CZSD @ NTS\$1,510. College of Management @ NTS\$1,400. College of Humanities and Social Sciences @ NTS\$1,390. Miscellaneous fees are calculated based on the proportion of enrolled credits to 9 credits. If enrolled credits are less than 1 credit (including non-course enrollment), it is calculated as 1 credit. Please refer to

6 For graduate students (including doctoral students from the fourth year onwards and master's students from the third year onwards) who are extension students, full tuition and miscellaneous fees are charged if they enroll in 10 credits or more per semester.

7 For graduate students (including doctoral students from the fourth year onwards and master's students from the third year onwards) who are extension students and enroll in 9 credits or fewer per semester, they will be charged credit fees as follows: College of Engineering, Information, Electrical and Communication @ NTS\$1,610; College of Management @ NTS\$1,510; College of Humanities and Social Sciences @ NTS\$1,500; Graduate Institute of Medicine @ NTS\$1,610. Additionally, miscellaneous fees are charged at 50% of the departmental standard. For the in-service Master's program of College of Management, tuition is NTS\$2,500 plus miscellaneous fees of NTS\$5,135; Doctoral Program in the Industry Group has a tuition of NTS\$12,000 plus miscellaneous fees of NTS\$5,135. Credits less than 1 (including those not requiring course selection) are calculated as 1 credit.

8 For students enrolled in the University's dual degree programs who are studying overseas, the tuition and miscellaneous fee regulations are as follows:
Graduate students (master's and doctoral programs) who have met the graduation requirements, or undergraduate students who have met the graduation requirements under the Yuan Ze University Regulations for Advanced Graduation on Academic Excellence, as confirmed by the Office of Academic Affairs, are only required to pay the miscellaneous fees during their period of overseas study. Students who do not meet the aforementioned qualifications are required to pay the full tuition and miscellaneous fees in accordance with university regulations. Students extending their period of study shall pay tuition and miscellaneous fees in accordance with the University's fee schedule for extended-study students.
