

Yuan Ze University Donation Appreciation Charter

Passed by the fourth school board's eighth meeting on 29 April 1999

Article 1 This charter is regulated to provide measures for extending appreciation to those who made contributions to this University for advancing education.

Article 2 The name of the individual or organisation benefactor and the fact of contribution shall be periodically published on Yuan Ze Newsletter, and appreciation letter issued accordingly.

Article 3 The roster of all contributions, identifying name and amount, shall be permanently displayed at the school history room, and individuals donating in the amount of over one million NTD shall be permanently included in the school benefactor directory published every school year.

Article 4 The measures of extending the University's gratitude to the benefactors are as follows:

1. Those contributed in amount under NT\$100,000 will receive an appreciation letter from the president.
2. Those contributed in amount over NT\$100,000 and under NT\$500,000 will receive a citation and an appreciation letter from the president.
3. Those contributed in amount over NT\$500,000 and under NT\$1,000,000 will receive a token memento and an appreciation letter from the president.
4. Those contributed in amount over NT\$1,000,000 and under NT\$3,000,000 will receive a token memento and an appreciation letter from the chairman of the school board.
5. Those contributed in amount over NT\$3,000,000 and under NT\$10,000,000 will receive a token memento and an appreciation letter from the chairman of the school board, together with an acknowledgement plaque at the campus history gallery.
6. Those contributed in amount over NT\$10,000,000 will receive a token memento and an appreciation letter from the chairman of the school board, together with an acknowledgement plaque at the campus

history gallery concomitant with the conferment of honorary alumnus/alumna stature.

7. Those contributed in amount over NT\$30,000,000 will be acknowledged as individual cases.

Article 5 Benefactors to the University's facilities buildings will be conferred the honorary alumni status and the honor of naming the building or hall in question as part of the University's legacy. The name nominated is subject to the approval of the administrative meeting and the school board; standards for the size of contribution shall be additionally regulated.

Article 6 In case of contributions to the University made in several times, where the aggregated amount reaches the standards set hitherto, the appreciation acknowledgement shall be based on the relevant provisions.

Article 7 For contributions made in the form of education and research related equipment, the name of the benefactor will be inscribed on the object, and gesture of appreciation extended according to the guidelines set forth hitherto. For contribution reaching the level as regulated in the Education Business Contribution Commendation Charter by the Ministry of Education, additional application therefor will be submitted.

Article 8 The manner of extending the University's gratitude towards its benefactors shall honor the individual benefactor's will in principle; in the case the benefactor wish to remain anonymous, the University has the responsibility to uphold absolute confidentiality.

Article 9 The Charter is subjected to the discussion of the Campus Development Foundation committee and the approval of the administrative meeting and presented to the chairman's approval signature; the amendment shall require the same.

[If there is any discrepancy in the interpretation of the meaning of the articles in a regulation, the Chinese version shall prevail.]
