Implementation Guidelines for Collaborative Teaching of Industry Experts

Passed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2013, on November 06, 2013

1. The establishment of implementation guidelines for collaborative teaching of industry experts (hereafter referred to as the Implementation Guidelines) aims to reinforce the connection between university education and industry, offer students seamless knowledge of the industry science and technology, and cultivate applied talents suitable for enterprise's needs.
2. Curriculum planning:
  - (1) Courses are classified as:
    - (a) Core courses- taught by Full-time faculty
    - (b) Practical/technical training/advanced courses- taught by industry experts alone or co-teaching with full-time faculty
    - (c) Elective courses- taught by Full-time or part-time faculty
  - (2) Department should keep up with the trend of the times and development orientation to open related courses or Seminars.
  - (3) Courses taught by industry experts must be approved by department, college and university curriculum committee.
  - (4) Department should define a rational ratio of courses taught by industry experts.
3. The qualification of industry expert should be examined by Teachers' Evaluation Committee.
4. The Implementation Guidelines are passed by the Academic Affairs Meeting and implemented afterwards. The same procedure will be repeated for each revision.
