

Yuan Ze University Regulations for Students Suffering Difficulty in Their Schooling As A Result of A Disaster

Approved by the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2015 School Year, September 30, 2015

Article 1 These regulations are provided pursuant to Article 64-1 of YZU Study Regulations.

Article 2 The following regulations shall be applicable to students suffering difficulty in their schooling as a result of a disaster.

Article 3 Students suffering difficulty in their schooling as a result of a disaster referred to in the regulations shall be recognized by the educational authority.

Article 4 Newly admitted students and transfer students may report to the university through mail and process enrollment along with relevant documents.

Article 5 Students who fail to return to school with expiration of the deferment may be granted for an extension of one more year on a case-by-case basis.

Article 6 The required minimum credits taken for each semester are not applicable to students referred to in the regulations. Students who take courses below the requirement shall pay credit fees for the courses they take.

Article 7 Students applying for suspension from schooling are exempt from the rule that no applications will be accepted after final exams. Students don't have to pay relevant tuition and fees; a refund shall be given back to the students if they have paid relevant tuition and fees. Students who fail to return to school with expiration of the suspension for two years may be granted for an extension of two more years on a case-by-case basis.

Article 8 The deadline to submit applications for withdrawal from schooling are not applicable to students referred to in the regulations. A refund shall be given back to the students if they have paid relevant tuition and fees.

Article 9 Students who fail to complete the required credits for graduation upon the stipulated term of study may be granted for an extension of one more year on a case-by-case basis.

Article 10 These regulations are adopted by Academic Affairs Meeting, as shall amendments when they are made.
