Academic Award and Diverse Skills Award Review Regulations College of Management, Yuan Ze University

Approved in the 3rd College Affairs Meeting of the 110th academic year on December 15, 110 Ratified in the 3rd Student Affairs Meeting of the 110th academic year on April 27, 111 Please see the Chinese version for the detailed history of regulation revision.

Article 1:

To encourage the students of the College of Management (hereinafter referred to as "the College") to excel in academic and diverse skills during their enrollment, these review regulations are established in accordance with the university's Student Reward Methods.

Article 2:

Students of the College are eligible to apply for the Academic Award if they meet the following conditions:

- Gold Academic Award: First place in national academic competitions, top three in international academic competitions, special honors in academic competitions, or undergraduate and master's students whose learning or research results have been published in well-known journals domestically or internationally and are classified as level I or II by the College.
- 2. Silver Academic Award: Top three in academic competitions organized by internal or external institutions, or undergraduate and master's students whose learning or research results have been published in well-known journals domestically or internationally and are classified as level III by the College.
- 3. Academic Achievement Award: Those who have received two Silver Academic Awards or one Gold Academic Award and again meet the qualifications for the Gold Award.

Article 3:

Students of the College are eligible to apply for the Diverse Skills Award if they meet the following conditions:

- 1. Gold Diverse Skills Award: Passed national higher examinations (including equivalent exams), A-level national technical certification, or outstanding language test scores recognized by the College (in accordance with the university's Student Reward Methods).
- 2. Silver Diverse Skills Award: Passed national general examinations (including equivalent exams), B-level national technical certification, or outstanding language test scores recognized by the College (in accordance with the university's Student Reward Methods).

3. Diverse Skills Achievement Award: Those who have received two Silver Diverse Skills Awards or one Gold Diverse Skills Award and again meet the qualifications for the Gold Award.

Article 4:

Students eligible for these awards may apply for program recommendation by themselves or through relevant units by providing relevant documents such as learning or research results, photocopies of papers published in well-known domestic or international journals, academic competition results or awards, and national examination or certification scores. After selection by the College, the results will be announced following approval by the Student Affairs Meeting of the Office of Student Affairs.

Article 5:

Matters not covered in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with the university's Student Reward Methods.

Article 6:

These regulations are implemented after approval by the College Affairs Meeting and ratification by the Student Affairs Meeting, and the same applies to any amendments.
