Student Academic Award and Multi-Skills Award Review Regulations, College of Humanities and Social Sciences, Yuan Ze University

Amended by the 3rd Student Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2021, on April 27, 2022

- Article 1 The College of Humanities and Social Sciences (hereinafter referred to as "the College") has formulated these regulations in accordance with the Student Award Scheme of the College in order to encourage students who present outstanding academic and multi-skill achievements during their study in the College.
- Article 2 Students who fulfill the following requirements are eligible to apply for the Academic or Multi-Skills Award:
 - Gold Medal in Academics: Those who have won the top three places in international academic competitions, the first place in national academic competitions, or honors. Undergraduate and master's students whose studies or research results have been published or accepted in prestigious domestic and international journals and A-ranked journals belonging to the College can apply for the same paper only once.
 - 2. Silver Medal in Academics: Students who have won the top three prizes in internal and external academic competitions. Undergraduate and master's degree students whose studies or research results have been published or accepted in famous domestic and foreign journals and B-level journals belonging to the College can apply for the same paper only once.
 - 3. Academic Achievement Award: Students who have received two Silver Medals or one Gold Medal in Academics are eligible to apply for the Gold Medal in Academics again.
 - 4. Multi-Skills Gold Award: Those who have passed the national higher education exams (including equivalent exams), the national technician's skills test or language test recognized by the colleges and universities with outstanding results (refer to the comparison table between the English test and the CEF of Yuan Ze University's award application categories).
 - 5. Multi-skills Silver Award: Those who have passed the national general examination (including equivalent examination), and those who have excelled in Grade B national technician skills test or language test as recognized by the colleges and universities (refer to YUCC awards to apply for various English tests and CEF comparison forms).
 - 6. Multi-Skills Achievement Award: Students who have received the Multi-Skills Silver Award twice or the Multi-Skills Gold Award once are eligible to apply for the Multi-Skills Gold Award again.
- Article 3 Students who meet the application requirements may apply to their respective departments, classes, or units at the same level for recommendation by themselves or the relevant organizations with relevant information such as study or research results, academic competition results, awards, etc. After a preliminary examination by the College, the application will be submitted to the Student Affairs Council for review and approval and then announced.
- Article 4 After the preliminary examination, the student affairs meeting will review and approve the application and announce the awards.
- Article 5 This is designed to provide students an opportunity to learn and learn from each other.
