

Yuan Ze University Scholarship Application Guidelines for Donated Scholarships from Various Sectors

April 14, 2023, The 2nd Scholarship Review Committee Meeting for the 111th Academic Year has been approved

- Article 1: The university has established this set of regulations to effectively manage and coordinate scholarships donated by various sources for academically excellent underprivileged students, in order to support their dedication to their studies.
- Article 2: Scholarships donated by various sources with specific purposes shall be utilized according to the specified purpose, and changes to the purpose shall not be made without written consent from the donor. If a scholarship is not designated for a specific purpose, it will be managed and utilized in accordance with these regulations.
- Article 3: Any undergraduate student currently enrolled at this university may apply for a scholarship if they meet all of the following conditions:
- I. Those from financially disadvantaged backgrounds or those facing sudden financial emergencies.
 - II. Those with a previous semester's average academic score of 75 or above, without any failing grades, and with conduct scores of 85 or higher, and no disciplinary record.
 - III. Those who have not received any other scholarships, whether from within or outside the university, for that semester will be given priority.
 - IV. Applicants must hold ROC nationality and be currently enrolled students at the university.
- Article 4: The scholarship is typically awarded at a rate of 5,000 NTD per student per semester. The number of awards and the amount of the scholarship are determined based on the annual donation amount for that year.
- Article 5: Each semester, after the start of the school year, the Office of Student Affairs will announce information related to scholarship applications. Applying students should submit the following documents within the specified deadline:
- I. Application form.
 - II. Academic transcripts and co-curricular activity records.
 - III. Proof of financial hardship (issued by the village chief) or evidence of sudden family changes.
 - IV. Other relevant supporting documents.
- Article 6: This scholarship will be announced by the Office of Student Affairs after preparing the list of applicants based on the aforementioned regulations and receiving approval from the university's Scholarship Review Committee.
- Article 7: Any matters not covered by this regulation will be handled in accordance with the "Yuan Ze University Educational Resource Development Fund Management Regulations."
- Article 8: This regulation shall be implemented following approval by the Scholarship Review Committee, and any amendments shall also follow the same procedure.
