

Yuan Ze University Student Activities Committee Organizational Rules

Ratified at the 2nd Student Affairs Meeting of the academic year on 9 December 1998
Amended at the 1st Student Affairs Meeting of the academic year on 18 October 2002
Amended at the 4th Student Affairs Meeting of the academic year on 21 May 2003
Amended at the 1st Student Affairs Meeting of the academic year on 17 November 2004

Clause 1: In order to strictly review applications for the establishment of clubs, strengthen the performance assessment of club work, and guide the healthy development of clubs, our university has specially established the "Student Activities Committee" (hereinafter referred to as the Committee).

Clause 2: The committee shall have seven to eleven members. Each college shall nominate one faculty as representative, one physical education faculty representative, and two student (Student Association) representatives. The committee chair may hire several professional faculties as representatives. The term of a committee member lasts one year, and all members are unpaid.

Clause 3: The committee has a chairperson who concurrently serves as the Dean, oversees all matters of the committee. However, when it is necessary, the Director of the Extracurricular Activities Section may be appointed as the convener of the meeting.

Clause 4: The responsibilities of this Committee are as follows:

1. Review and approve newly established clubs.
2. Review and finalize decisions on clubs' subsidy funds.
3. Handle and resolve disputes between clubs.
4. Hear and review punishments for club violations.
5. Review rewards for club cadres and medals for services, talents, and activities at all levels.
6. Deliberate other issues related to the clubs.

Clause 5: These simple rules shall be implemented upon approval by the Student Affairs Committee, and the same situations should be applied when revised.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding the clauses of the regulations, it shall always refer to the Chinese version.
