

Implementation Details for Club/Organization Evaluation at Yuan Ze University

- Clause 1 This set of details is established to evaluate the work efficiency of the club/organization, encourage service enthusiasm, promote activity quality and realize the function of the club/organization.
- Clause 2 All general student clubs/organizations that have been established for a full year at YZU and the student autonomy organizations should participate in the club/organizational evaluation. The evaluation each academic year is based on the announcement.
- Clause 3 The evaluation committee members will be recommended by the Extracurricular Activity Group under the Office of Student Affairs. On- and off-campus experts to the related activities will be recommended. The Head of the Office of Student Affairs will screen the recommended experts and select the most appropriate ones.
- Clause 4 The evaluation items are based on the nature of the clubs/organizations. The categories are club/organizational satisfaction levels, resource use, documents/information, and activity records. Those who are evaluated to earn more than 90 points will be rated as Excellent. Those earning 80 points will be rated as A Level, 70 points B Level, 60 points C Level, and lower than 60 points D Level.
- Clause 5 The following rewards or penalties would be given according to the club/organization evaluation results.
- I. Excellence: a reward certificate will be given and money may be given depending on situations. The responsible person for the club/organization and the well-performed staff members can apply for medals and be recommended to represent the university to participate in the national excellent club/organization.
 - II. A Level: a reward certificate will be given and money may be given depending on situations. The responsible person for the club/organization and the well-performed staff members can apply for medals.

- III. C Level: the club/organization will be listed for enforced consultation.
- IV. D Level: a certain time frame will be imposed for improvement and re-evaluation. If the club/organization fails to show any improvement in the re-evaluation, its activities may be suspended for a semester or the club/organization may be dismissed.
- V. The clubs/organizations that have not held any event in the entire academic year will be reported for dismissal once the situations are verified.

Clause 6 All student organizations at YZU will have to be evaluated with this set of regulations. Those failing to participate in the evaluation will not be allowed to apply for funding or subsidies and cannot be assigned an office like other general clubs/organizations.

Clause 7 Any matters not stipulated in this set of details, “Club/Organization Evaluation Implementation Key Points” can be stipulated additionally.

Clause 8 This set of details is ratified in the Student Affair meeting before implementation. All amendments require the same procedures.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
