

# Establishment Details for Common Fellowship at Yuan Ze

Clause 1 This set of details is established to assist the students coming from families with middle or low-level income to complete their studies.

Clause 2 The applicants have to be students formally admitted by YZU. Those who have extended their studies are not qualified.

Clause 3 The subsidized criteria and amounts are as follows:

- I. The subsidy is classified into five levels based on the families' annual income and excluding the categories of students from low-income families, with disabilities, from aborigine's background, and the remaining family members from military members or government officials.
  - (1) Those who are from families with less than NT\$300,000 annual income and without the exempt or waiver from the government support can apply for this subsidy. Each person will be subsidized NT\$33,000 each academic year.
  - (2) Those who are from families with more than NT\$300,000 but less than NT\$400,000 annual income and without the exempt or waiver from the government support can apply for this subsidy. Each person will be subsidized NT\$25,000 each academic year.
  - (3) Those who are from families with more than NT\$400,000 but less than NT\$500,000 annual income and without the exempt or waiver from the government support can apply for this subsidy. Each person will be subsidized NT\$20,000 each academic year.
  - (4) Those who are from families with more than NT\$500,000 but less than NT\$600,000 annual income and without the exempt or waiver from the government support can apply for this subsidy. Each person will be subsidized NT\$15,000 each academic year.
  - (5) Those who are from families with more than NT\$600,000 but less than NT\$700,000 annual income and without the exempt or waiver from the government support can apply for this subsidy. Each person will be subsidized NT\$10,000 each academic year.

- II. This fellowship/subsidy is only made available for subsidizing the tuition and miscellaneous fees for students from middle- and low-income families. Their life subsidies can be covered with an additional application of diligence fellowships.

Clause 4 The follow documents are required: an original copy for the family members issued in the past three months.

Clause 5 Application procedures are as follows:

- I. This fellowship/subsidy is processed once each academic year. The applications should be submitted within the time frame stipulated by the Ministry of Education. The students should submit their applications to the Life Consultation Division under the Office of Student Affairs. No late application would be processed.
- II. All the students who have met the application requirements stipulated by this set of details should fill out the application form and attach the above-mentioned documents within the regulated time.

Clause 6 Those students who have applied for waivers or exempts in a current academic year or those who have been awarded with other types of subsidies provided by the government or granted with waivers of tuition or miscellaneous fees can only be awarded with one fellowship. No repeated subsidies will be granted.

Clause 7 The funding source of this fellowship/subsidy is the annual subsidized funds from the handling of tuition and miscellaneous fee payments.

Clause 8 This set of details is ratified by the Student Affair meeting before implementation. All amendments require the same procedures.
