Yuan Ze University Subsidy Guidelines for Low-Income Students' Accommodation Assistance

Passed during the 96th academic year, 3rd Student Affairs Meeting on May 21, 2008.

- Article 1: These guidelines are established to alleviate the housing burden on low-income students at Yuan Ze University and demonstrate the university's care for students.
- Article 2: Students who reside in university dormitories and possess a valid low-income household certificate issued by the local government are eligible to apply.

Article 3: Application process:

- a. The accommodation subsidy will be processed once per semester. Applicants should submit their applications to the Office of Student Affairs within one month from the start of the semester. Late applications will not be accepted.
- b. Applicants must provide a completed application form and a photocopy of the low-income household certificate.
- Article 4: The full amount of the subsidy will be granted based on the annual accommodation fee collection standard.
- Article 5: Students who receive the low-income student accommodation subsidy are not eligible to apply for a refund if they withdraw from the university midway through the academic year.
- Article 6: These guidelines will be implemented after being approved by the Student Affairs Meeting and will follow the same procedure for any amendments.
