Yuan Ze University Faculty Dormitory Management Regulations

Passed by the 15th Administrative Committee of the 1989 School Year, March 5, 1990

Approved by the Board of Trustees, April 26, 1990

Amended by the 6th Administrative Committee of the 2023 School Year, October 18, 2023

- Article 1. The University's faculty dormitory refers to the residences and rooms provided for the University's president and deputy presidents, full-time professors (i.e., Assistant Professors and above), and scholars and visitors invited for short-term teaching and research at the University.
- Article 2. The classification, maintenance, and management of faculty dormitory is divided as follows:
 - 1. The residences of University's president and deputy presidents will be maintained and managed by the Office of General Affairs.
 - 2. The teacher housing of full-time professors will be maintained and managed by the residents' self-organized management committee.
 - 3. The faculty dormitory for distinguished Professors, chair Professors, and invited scholars and guests will be maintained and managed by the Office of General Affairs.
- Article 3. To foster, preserve, and sustain the hygiene, order, safety, and quality of the housing environments, management entities may create their own rules as necessary for residents to comply.
- Article 4. The University's administrative meeting must validate these regulations before they can be implemented on the date of promulgation; the same procedure shall be applied when they are amended.
- If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
