

YZU Regulations for Children of Faculty And Staff Studying in YZU Applying for Scholarship

Passed by the 4th Administrative Committee of the 1993 School Year, August 30, 1993

Amended by the 18th Administrative Committee of the 2006 School Year, June 25, 2007

Article 1 The application of scholarship for children of full-time faculties and staffs studying in YZU shall be processed in accordance with these regulations.

Article 2 The objective applicants of scholarship shall be limited to children of those organizational full-time faculties and staffs.

Article 3 The applicant whose scores reach the application standard shall be offered with the scholarship equals to the amount of tuition and fee for one semester. (The average score of a semester must be above 70, none of the subjects is failed, the conduct score must be above 80; the average score of a semester must be above 80 for those who are graduate students.)

Article 4 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, these regulations have been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
