

YZU Regulations for Commending Senior Faculty And Staff

Passed by the 6th Administrative Committee of the 1999 School Year, January 17, 2000

Article 1 These regulations are established to commend senior faculties and staffs of University who devote themselves to the job of teaching and to promote the harmony among offices or departments, to declare the spirit of harmonious education.

Article 2 These regulations apply to full-time organizational or contract-based faculties and staffs who have served University for ten, twenty, or thirty years.

Article 3 For those who apply for position retained without salary, the period of position retained without salary shall not be counted into the seniority for the commendation.

Article 4 Commendations will be given in prizes and memorial medals by President before each Chinese New Year based on the following standards:

1. Those who have served University for ten years will be given a prize of NT\$6,000 and a memorial medal.
2. Those who have served University for twenty years will be given a prize of NT\$15,000 and a memorial medal.
3. Those who have served University for thirty years will be given a prize of NT\$30,000 and a memorial cup.

Article 5 Personnel Office shall make a budget plan each year for funding this commendation.

Article 6 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, these regulations have been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
