

YZU Regulations for Offering Faculty And Staff Emergency Aid

Passed by the 3rd Administrative Committee of the 2000 School Year, October 23, 2000

Article 1 “YZU Regulations for Offering Faculty And Staff Emergency Aid” (hereafter, ‘these regulations’) are established to offer financial help for University faculties and staffs who have serious accidents, illnesses or who are in big troubles during their service period.

Article 2 These regulations apply to full-time faculties, staffs, and contract-based personnel of University.

Article 3 The emergency aid can be applied for any of the following occasions during the service period:

1. Serious injury or sickness, for which the patient can’t afford the medical expenses.
2. The family that is impoverished due to other major causes.
3. Other cases that have been recognized for the subsidy.

Article 4 Sources of the emergency aid:

1. University will allot an amount of two hundred fifty thousand NT dollars to fund for the emergency aid.
2. Contributions from University’s faculties and staffs or from people of different fields.

Article 5 In order to make a safekeeping of the fund and to make best use of it, University will set up a ‘Management Committee of The Fund of Emergency Aid’ that is consisted of the following personnel: Chief of Personnel Office will be the convener; Dean of General Affairs, Chief Secretary, Chief of Controller Office, a representative of Personnel Review Committee, a committee chairman representative of YZU Employees’ Welfare Committee will be the committee members whose term of office shall be one year.

Article 6 Duties of Management Committee of The Fund of Emergency Aid:

1. Matters of raising and managing the funds.
2. Matters of the verification of application and distribution of emergency aid.

Article 7 The distribution of emergency aid has a limitation between thirty thousand and fifty thousand NT dollars for one accident per person. In the case of injury or illness caused by duty, a larger amount of emergency aid can be applied. If the aid is insufficient for the applicant’s specific condition, University can have an extra donation for the applicant.

Article 8 The application of emergency aid shall be filed within two months beginning from the date of the accident.

Article 9 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, this regulation has been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
