

## **YZU Emeritus Professor Establishment Regulations**

Passed by the 14<sup>th</sup> Administrative Committee of the 2000 School Year, July 18, 2001

Amended by the 11<sup>th</sup> Administrative Committee of the 2004 School Year, November 22, 2004

Amended by the 16<sup>th</sup> Administrative Committee of the 2004 School Year, January 24, 2005

Amended by the 9<sup>th</sup> Administrative Committee of the 2006 School Year, January 8, 2007

Article 1 These regulations are established to honor the professors who have outstanding contributions in teaching, doing researches, or administration by titling them as Emeritus Professor upon retirement from University.

Article 2 Professors who meet the following criteria may be considered for emeriti designation:

1. Shown excellence in teaching or taking administrative positions, having significant contributions to University's planning, building, and development, having a minimum of ten years of service as a full-time professor of University.
2. Having made outstanding contributions to University in the field of scholarship, having been famous internationally, and having a minimum of ten years of service as a full-time professor of University.
3. Having been University's lecture course professor.

Article 3 The contract of Emeritus Professor is lifelong. If the professor is found in the situations mentioned in the subparagraphs of Article 14 of Teacher's Act, President will terminate his/her contract.

Article 4 Candidates of Emeritus Professor shall be recommended by the college dean to President for approval and shall be appointed with the approval of present members of Teacher Evaluation Committee of School.

Article 5 Emeritus Professor is a title without remuneration and the obligation to teach; colleges or departments may invite Emeritus Professor to teach related courses with an hourly pay in accordance with the payment standard for part-time faculties.

Article 6 Emeritus Professor can use all public facilities in University. With approvals from the departments or offices, Emeritus Professor can use University's research rooms or labs. Emeritus Professor may direct graduate students with their theses or participate in the job of lecturing and doing research.

Article 7 Emeritus Professor who has been appointed as a lecture course professor before retiring from University can be specially appointed as 'Emeritus Lecture Course'. In order to get assistance from 'Emeritus Lecture Course' to promote teaching and researching, the

school can make a special budget for the pay and expenses needed.

Article 8 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, these regulations have been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.

**If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.**
