

YZU Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor Establishment Regulations

Passed by the 4th Administrative Committee of the 2001 School Year, September 26, 2001

Article 1 These regulations are established in accordance with Article 8 of “YZU Lecture Course Establishment Regulations”.

Article 2 The honor of ‘Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor’ is established to reward professors who have outstanding performance in the research field of environmental protection, to enhance University’s academic and research standard of environmental protection, and to develop more professionals of this field.

Article 3 Candidates shall meet the following criteria: Having engaged in teaching or academic research in domestic or foreign universities or institutes for over twenty years, having made important contributions or accomplishments that have been recognized by international academia, having served as a full-time professor of the school’s College of Engineering.

Article 4 President shall recommend the candidates and the selection of ‘Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor’ shall be verified by Teacher Evaluation Committee of School.

Article 5 ‘Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor’ will be given a lecture course contract. The professor will be offered a yearly prize of NT\$600,000 dollars from the school’s research funds in addition to the basic salary of a full-time professor.

Article 6 The contract period for ‘Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor’ is three years each term and the extension of contract shall be approved by President.

Article 7 Publications of the professors mentioned above shall be indicated with the title of ‘Environmental Protection Lecture Course Professor’. The professors can be the host or consultant of national or international conferences held by University.

Article 8 Prior to promulgation and enforcement, this regulation has been passed by Administrative Committee, the same for amendment.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
