

YZU Management Lecture Course Professor Establishment Regulations

Passed by the 21st Administrative Committee of the 2003 School Year, June 30, 2004

Article 1 These regulations are established to reward Management Lecture Course Professor in accordance with Article 8 of “YZU Lecture Course Establishment Regulations”.

Article 2 The honor is established to appeal domestic or foreign scholars who are famous to teach, do research and integrate the resources in the field of management, to enhance University’s academic standard of management, and to develop more professionals of this field.

Article 3 Candidates shall meet the following criteria: Having engaged in teaching or academic research in domestic or foreign universities or institutes, having made important contributions or accomplishments, having served as a full-time professor of Graduate School of Management.

Article 4 Selection procedures: Candidates submit the proposal while applying for ‘Management Lecture Course Professor’ and the selection shall be verified by Teacher Evaluation Committee of School.

Article 5 Contract period: From August 1st, 2004 to July 31st, 2006 and can be extended with approvals of both University and the professor.

Article 6 The professors can direct the development of management or give related speeches in University, and they can also be the host or consultant of national or international conferences held by University.

Article 7 Payment standard: The professors will be offered a yearly prize of NT\$450,000 dollars in addition to the basic salary of a full-time professor. The prize comes from two sources: University shall make a budget of NT\$200,000 dollars each year and College of Management shall be responsible for NT\$250,000 dollars.

Article 8 These regulations are adopted by Administrative Committee, reported to President for ratification and implementation, as shall amendments when they are made.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding clauses of the contract, it shall always refer to its Chinese version.
