

Yuan Ze University Innovation Center for Big Data and Digital Convergence Regulations on the Establishment of Scholarships and Grants for Students from Mainland China

(Applicable from Academic Year 2014 onward)

Sep. 17, 2014 Adopted at the 4th Administrative Committee Meeting, Academic Year 2014

- Article 1 For the purpose of encouraging outstanding g students from Mainland China (including degree-seeking students, students in dual-degree programs, and exchange students) to pursue studies at the University, the Big Data and Digital Convergence Innovation Center (hereinafter referred to as “the Center”) hereby establishes these Regulations.
- Article 2 The details of the scholarships, eligibility requirements, application procedures, and award period are as follows:
1. Scholarship Coverage: the scholarships shall provide research stipends and/or living allowances.
 2. Eligibility and Application Procedure: applications shall be submitted by relevant research teams and faculty members of the Center. Upon review and approval by the Center, eligible students may be awarded research stipends and/or living allowances.
 3. Award Period: each application may be approved for a period of up to one year. Each student may receive scholarships for a maximum cumulative period of four years.
- Article 3 The monthly amount of research scholarships for students from Mainland China shall be determined in accordance with different academic programs or class categories, with an upper limit of NTD 12,000 per month. The scholarships shall be funded by the matching funds of the Center under the YZU Toward Top University Project.
- Article 4 Recipients who suspend their studies at the University for any reason or whose academic or research performance is deemed unsatisfactory shall be ineligible to continue receiving this scholarship or stipend.
- Article 5 If any applicant is found to have obtained the scholarship or stipend through forged, falsified, or otherwise untrue information, the University shall revoke the award, and any scholarship or stipend already disbursed shall be subject to repayment.

Article 6 These Regulations, as well as all subsequent revisions therewith, shall be duly adopted by the Administrative Council prior to implementation.

The English translation is for reference only. In case of any discrepancy between Chinese and English versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
