

Regulations for the Allocation of Management Fees for Lifelong Education at Yuan Ze University

Article 1: In order to actively promote the business of continuing education at our university, increase the university's financial resources, and regulate the allocation ratio of funds for various units to conduct different types of promotional courses, these measures are hereby established.

Article 2: These measures apply to the funds allocated for various credit and non-credit promotional education courses conducted by the Lifelong Education Department, colleges, departments, and research centers at our university.

Article 3: The allocation ratio standards for various courses are as follows:

1. For courses where the ratio of management fees is already defined by external entrusted units, the ratio specified by those units shall apply.
2. For other types of courses, the allocation ratio shall be determined based on the nature of their responsibilities, as specified in the table below:

Nature of responsibilities	Allocation ratio
Each unit independently plans and organizes various promotional education programs.	30%
The Lifelong Education Department is responsible for administrative operations such as enrollment, promotion, registration, grade consolidation, and completion. The departments, institutes, colleges, and programs are responsible for planning, faculty selection, course management, and other instructional tasks.	40%
Our university collaborates with mainland Chinese universities to offer 3+1 cooperative programs.	40%

3. For promotional education courses independently planned and organized by the Lifelong Education Department, a management fee may be allocated at a rate of 20%. After deducting operational costs incurred during course implementation, the remaining surplus shall be transferred as school management fees. The total of the management fees and surplus is designed to achieve a management fee ratio of 30% or above. For competitive project proposals with an annual budget not exceeding NT\$2.5 million, the minimum management fee may be allocated at a rate of 10%.
4. If any unit responsible for organizing such programs fails to meet the management fee allocation ratio, implementation shall be subject to approval by the President.

Article 4: The budget proposals for promotional education courses from colleges, departments, and research centers must be reviewed and approved by the Lifelong Education Department, following the university's administrative procedures, before

funds can be disbursed.

Article 5: These measures shall be implemented upon approval by the Administrative Meeting and shall also apply to any future amendments.
